

# Plattsburgh Sunrise Rotary Adds City to List of 2009 Benefactors

Plattsburgh, NY (March 9, 2010) – In a press conference on February 5, 2010, Randy Giltz, President, Sunrise Rotary Club of Plattsburgh, announced the results of its fundraising efforts from Mayor's Cup 2009, and presented the City of Plattsburgh - its largest benefactor - with \$8,500 earmarked for a Plattsburgh Waterfront Park project. This pledge represents 50% of Sunrise Rotary's net profits from 2009 Mayor's Cup sponsor contributions. Giltz also indicated that Sunrise Rotary will pledge 50% of net profits from its Mayor's Cup sponsor contributions in 2010. This waterfront project is yet to be finalized, and ideas are welcome. An active volunteer civic organization, Plattsburgh Sunrise Rotary consists of local business leaders dedicated to helping our local and world community. The Club contributes – in the form of funding and resources – toward various community events and projects each year. In addition to Mayor's Cup, its largest community event and fundraiser, Sunrise Rotary has donated \$9,150, since July 2009, to other local charities and non-profit organizations, including the North Country Chapter of the American Red Cross, Battle of Plattsburgh, CVPH Foundation, Habitat for Humanity, SUNY Plattsburgh (Scholarships for Locals), United Way, Berkshire Farms, American Cancer Society, Treasure Chest (Breast Cancer Awareness), Family Promise, and the St. Peter's Food Shelf; and \$8,000 toward international projects, including the Kakanada Cataract Surgery Clinic in India, Rotary International's eradication of Polio, and to purchase ShelterBoxes for international disaster relief.
